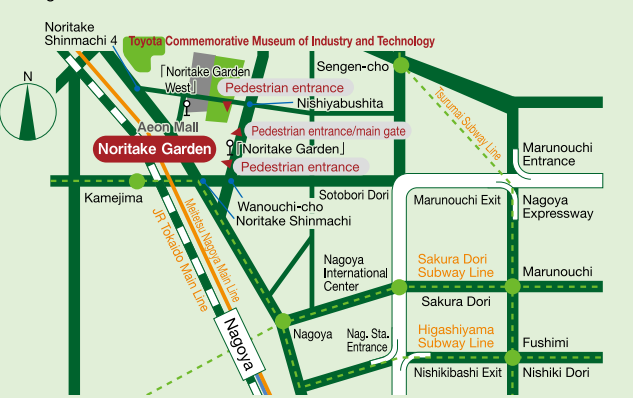

The Kiln Wall preserves history for future generations

This retaining wall, made of old brick that was first used as the solid foundation of the original factory building, contains plates inscribed with the names of donors to the Noritake Garden Foundation.
